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PRELATE'S ADDRESS TO THE CONFERENCE YOUTH WEEK FROM MONDAY 20TH TO SUNDAY

THEME: "I WILL FIGHT FOR YOU" (EXODUS 14:14)

Beloved Children in Christ,

Grace, mercy, and peace from God our Father and from our Lord Jesus Christ.

It is with deep joy and a strong sense of Apostolic responsibility that I address you on the occasion of the 2026 Conference Youth Week. This sacred period in the life of Methodist Church Nigeria is set aside to focus on you — our youths who remain a vital force in the life, growth, and future of this church.

We thank God for your lives, your energy, and your contributions. At the same time, this moment calls for reflection on your identity, your place, and your responsibility within the household of faith.

Theme of Conference: I Will Fight for You (Exodus 14:14)

The Conference theme for this year, *"I Will Fight for You" (Exodus 14:14)*, is a divine assurance given to God's people in a moment of fear, pressure, and uncertainty. It is a promise that speaks powerfully to you as youths in this present generation.

In understanding this theme, it is important to first recognize **who you are**.
